

Intercoiffure America-Canada Announces Student Contest Rising Star Competition to Name North America's Top Cosmetology Students

Six-time NAHA award winner Vivienne Mackinder recently announced an exciting new contest for North American cosmetology students. The Rising Star Competition is a new division of Intercoiffure America Canada (ICA), a group of top salons and stylists in North America.

This brand-new contest offers an extraordinary educational and networking opportunity, bringing North America's top 200 cosmetology students to the exclusive Intercoiffure Spring Symposium in Miami, Florida, on April 17–18, 2011, where they'll have the opportunity to network with elite salons from the U.S. and Canada and compete in the final phase of the Rising Star Competition.

Rising Star is an excellent opportunity for students to shine and for their schools to be represented as the best of the best.

In Phase 1, school owners, leaders, and instructors select one star student to represent their school; students must meet or be pursuing criteria from the Dean's Honours List (below).

In Phase 2, the selected students will bring their pre-styled mannequin head and stand to exhibit their work at ICA's Spring Symposium, where they will be judged by a team of 12 Intercoiffure judges including Vivienne Mackinder and ICA President Lois Christie. The contest includes an open viewing of their work (post judging) to all Intercoiffure members, allowing top salon owners to meet all 200 students, see their work, connect, and exchange business cards.

- Dean's Honours List score sheet (see below).
- Professional head shot of student
- Mission statement about being a hairdresser, colorist, etc. (less than 100 words)

<u>Phase 2: Judging Considerations and Competition</u> Criteria

- Hair will be judged for technical skill, creativity, fashion sense, and taste level.
- Styles shown: short, medium, or long cut with color.
- Selected students will be given one of 6 themes before coming to Intercoiffure: Street, Couture, Eclectic, Classic, Bohemian, Minimalist.
- Students will bring their prepared manneguin head to the event.
- There will 33 students per group (based on 200 attending).
- The 12 judges (2 per group) will select a winner and runner-up for each group.
- The top 12 winners receive "sponsors" prizes.
- Judging: April 17th at 4:00 5:30 PM.
- The top 12 awards will be presented on stage.
- Open viewing of work will take place (post judging) at the Saturday evening pre-cocktail party, April 17th at 6:00 - 7:30 PM.
